**Format:** Class is open to students of all levels – beginners learn how to play chess, while more experienced students work on improving their strategy. A portion of each class is devoted to instruction and a portion to play (students are matched with those of similar ability). Students participate in chess and team chess tournaments during the second part of this session.
